EXHIBITION "HISTORICAL IMPRINTS OF LINGNAN: MAJOR ARCHAEOLOGICAL DISCOVERIES OF GUANGDONG, HONG KONG AND MACAU"

MONDAY (SEPT 29)
DESIGN AND DISASTER EXHIBITION:
KON WAJIRO'S MODERNOLOGIO

This exhibition presents drawings by Japanese architect Kon Wajiro (1888-1973), focusing on his observations of everyday life in Tokyo after the devastating 1923 earthquake. The work in the exhibition is primarily drawn from his book Modernologio and his surveys of "barracks" (makeshift structures for earthquake relief). Emphasizing Kon's urban ethnography, as well as its significance as a design-based methodology for recording material change in post-disaster conditions, the drawings and photographs derive from observations of urban and domestic spaces in early-twentieth-century Tokyo, as well as from detailed recordings of people's dress, body postures, and movement.
